



# Summer Program Meals

Coalition for Kids will provide three meals each day:

- Breakfast
- Lunch
- Afternoon Snack

Families have two options for their child's meals:

## 1) Lunch Packer

### If you choose to send meals from home:

- You must send breakfast, lunch, and a snack for your child every day.
- You may also feed your child breakfast prior to arriving.

### **Please Note:**

- Your child will not be included on the list to receive meals from C4K.
- Your child will not go through the meal line at meal times.

## 2) C4K Provided Meals

### If you choose to have C4K provide meals:

- Your child will go through the hot meal line at each meal time.
- If your child requires allergy-related meal substitutions, a medical form completed during registration is required.
- While children are not required to eat everything served, they must sit down with a meal during each designated meal period.

**Please review both options and decide which works best for your family.**





# Summer Program

## Field Trips

Coalition for Kids is excited to offer a variety of engaging and enriching field trips as part of our summer program. These experiences are designed to enhance learning and create fun memories for our students.

### Field Trip Schedule

Families will receive a field trip calendar outlining all scheduled trips, including dates and locations. Please review it carefully and plan accordingly.

### Field Trip Eligibility

Field trips are a fun and educational part of our summer programming. To participate, students must show positive behavior while on campus. Coalition for Kids reserves the right to determine if a child may attend a field trip based on behavior.

### Parent Attendance Policy

#### For the safety and structure of our program:

Parents are not permitted to attend field trips. If a parent arrives at a field trip location, they will be required to check their student out for the day.

### How to Prepare for Field Trips

Dress your child in comfortable, activity appropriate clothing and footwear. Send a filled water bottle labeled with your child's name. Do not send money. Coalition for Kids does not allow students to purchase items during field trips.

### Supervision

Program staff accompany students on the Coalition for Kids bus to and from the field trip. Students remain in groups with program staff through the duration of the field trip to ensure proper supervision and safety.





# Summer Program

## Pool Days

As part of our Summer Program, students will have the opportunity to visit a local pool for supervised swim days. Please review the important information below to ensure your child is prepared.

### What to Wear

- Students should arrive to C4K with their swimwear on under their clothing
- Students should wear comfortable clothing that is easy to change out of

### What to Bring

- A small towel to dry off with
- A full change of clothes including under garments
- We suggest sending a plastic bag to put wet items in
- Please **do not** send pool toys

### Supervision and Safety

- Lifeguards will be on duty at the pool
- Coalition for Kids staff will also be stationed throughout the pool to supervise
- Students' will remain in areas of the pool that are appropriate for their swim experience

### Sunscreen

All sunscreen application and reapplication will follow C4K policy and be properly documented. Additional details can be found in the registration packet.





# Summer Program

## Drop Off and Pick Up

To ensure the safety and smooth operation of our program, please review the following drop-off and pick-up procedures carefully.

### Morning Car Line

- Students must be dropped off through the morning car line
- The car line operates daily from 7:30-8:15am
- A staff member must be present to accept and check in your child
- Never leave your child unattended outside of the building
- No code is required for drop off

### Afternoon Pick Up

- Parents and guardians must park and come inside to check out their child
- Afternoon check out operates daily from 4:00-5:30pm
- Children will only be released to their approved pick up persons
- To check out a student, you will be required to:
  - Enter the check out code
  - Show a photo ID

### Parking Lot Procedures

- Parents will receive a document that demonstrates how to enter car line
- Drivers should use caution and a slow speed for the safety of our students
- Students should remain in the vehicle until the car has reached our staff





# Summer Program

## Dress Code

We encourage students to dress comfortably for a fun, active day! Clothing should be appropriate for daily activities, outdoor play, and field trips.

### What to Wear

- Comfortable clothing suitable for the day's activities
- Shorts that reach at least mid-thigh
- Shirts that fully cover the midriff (belly button covered at all times)
- Full coverage swimwear

### Not Permitted

- Inappropriate language, graphics, or logos

### Footwear

Students participate in daily physical activity, including outdoor play and active games. While we do not require a specific type of shoe, we strongly recommend comfortable, secure footwear that allows students to run and play safely.
